Proposed Curfew Law

It shall be illegal for persons under the age of 18 to be out of their homes from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday nights. On Friday and Saturday nights, the curfew shall be extended until midnight. Violators will be fined \$100. Young people chaperoned by adults, attending a planned community activity or traveling to or from work are the only exceptions.
